The text is aligned to the width without hyphenation. All charts and tables must be inserted into the text. Paragraph indent-1.25. A maximum of 2 charts and tables are allowed to be inserted into the text. The leaf orientation is bookish. Footnotes to the text are indicated in square brackets with the number of the source in the list of references. All sources listed in the list of references should be referenced in the text of the paper.

### REFERENCES REQUIREMENTS

The list of references is drawn up in accordance with ISO-690. Sources in the list are arranged in alphabetical order. The list of references should include mainly monographs, scientific Papers in journals included in international citation systems. Legal documents and statistical materials are not included in the list of sources. If the papers do not meet the above requirements, they will not be accepted for publication. Papers are accepted for publication after expert review.
